

Action Alert!

This past week various Colorado Legislative Committees passed bills on to the full legislature for vote. These bills are serious enough that Colorado Catholic Conference has called for an Action Alert on each bill.

Oppose: HB24-1124 "Discrimination in Places of Public Accommodation". This bill may greatly affect Catholic Hospitals, Schools & Shelters. HB 1124 will add "non-profits" as subject to Colorado's non-discrimination law financial penalties. HB 1124 will force every person and institution to conform to government-mandated beliefs about sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression under threat of criminal and financial penalties of \$10,000.

Oppose: HB24-1028 "Overdose Prevention Centers"

Support: HB24-1280 "Welcome, Reception & Integration Grant Program"
