





Pascal Fast

"Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be observed everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, as a way of coming to the joys of the Sunday of the resurrection with uplifted and welcoming heart."

(Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy # 110)

As an ancient tradition, all who are physically able, are encouraged to take part in the Pascal Fast which begins after mass on Holy Thursday, ending after the Easter Vigil. All are encouraged to abstain from meat and fast through a reduction in meals. This time is meant to be spent in prayer to prepare for Easter.
